Make this fun clock and learn about time and greetings throughout the day like:

Good afternoon
Good evening
Goodnight

Instructions:

1. Print pages 1 - 4 double-sided. (Or glue them together)
2. Cut out the red and green hands, and cut out the circles along the dotted lines. Don't forget to cut out the white "window" area.
3. (optional) Laminate all the parts and cut them out again. (This will make the clock last much longer.)
4. Assemble the clock with a rivet. (You can use a brad, but a rivet is safer and permanent.)
5. Now it's ready! Spin the back disc to change the time of day from morning to afternoon to evening to night.
6. Scan the QR Code to use the Digital Interactive Flashcard Set.


