### Good Morning, Clock!



Make this fun clock and learn about time and greetings throughout the day like:

Good morning Good afternoon Good evening Goodnight

#### Instructions:

- 1. Print pages 1 4 double-sided. (Or glue them together)
- 2. Cut out the red and green hands, and cut out the circles along the dotted lines. Don't forget to cut out the white "window" area.
- 3. (optional) Laminate all the parts and cut them out again.
  (This will make the clock last much longer.
- 4. Assemble the clock with a rivet.
  (You can use a brad, but a rivet is safer and permanent.)
- 5. Now it's ready! Spin the back disc to change the time of day from morning to afternoon to evening to night.
- 6. Scan the QR Code to use the Digital Interactive Flashcard Set.
